Le Cupole di Trinoro 1999

£315.98

19% Merlot, 23% Cabernet Franc, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon and 23% Troia

A stunning colour, almost opaque plum ruby, dense to bright, firm rim. The nose is headily spiced with fresh herbs and sweet, ripe, supple cherry fruits leading onto a palate which offers extraordinary concentration. The wine is certainly very big and meaty and yet somehow balances vibrancy and fresh primary fruit with a richness, depth and silky texture. Effortlessly balanced and a super wine.

Tenuta di Trinoro 1999

£697.85

70% Cabernet Franc, 20% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Petit Verdot.

Black shot crimson velvet, opaque and intense, Tenuta di Trinoro is immediately appealing. Spiced and smoky, authoritative and powerful there is a wealth of opulent fruit which is translated onto the palate. Dark cherry liqueur, bitter chocolate, vanilla cream and grilled fruits vie for dominance but are held in check by a firm structure and lively acidity. An amazingly long, layered and complex finish.

Palazzi 1999

£627.35

45% Merlot, 55% Cabernet Franc

Dark ruby velvet, shot with black the colour once again is lovely, with intensity and richness prevalent throughout. Supple, lavishly spiced, black cherries and spice, hints of marzipan and vanillin attack the nose and palate - enormous, vibrant and complex. Such balance of weight with alert, vital fruit is a remarkable achievement and makes for a truly memorable wine.
