

2005 Tenuta di Trinoro Tenuta di Trinoro Toscana Rosso

Deep ruby. Aromas of red cherry jam, violet, milk chocolate and cedary oak are complimented by perfumed notes of incense, bay leaf, oregano, thyme and tomato paste. On the palate, the notes of violet, chocolate and cedar speak more of the two cabernets and the petit verdot, while the merlot expresses itself in the wine's juicy softness. Remarkably graceful on the palate, with this estate's trademark extremely sweet, ripe, soft and smooth fruit really shining through. Shows seamless tannins, fine acidity and a compellingly long finish. This is actually a lighter-styled vintage for Trinoro, but this wine is a paradigm of balance.

2005 Tenuta di Trinoro Le Cupole Toscana Rosso

Medium red. Sweet, captivating red cherry aroma complicated by floral red berries and a touch of grass. Very refreshing though not particularly complex on the palate, where a burst of ripe, juicy red cherry fruit is joined by cedar and tobacco. The fairly long finish boasts a very smooth texture.

2004 Tenuta di Trinoro Tenuta di Trinoro Toscana Rosso

Deep red-ruby. Ripe, pure black cherry, spicy plum, black pepper and hints of mocha on the nose, with the slightest hint of a roasted character. Lush and seamless on the palate, with copious quantities of sweet ripe red plum, black cherry, oregano, and coffee liqueur enlivened by a delicate minty nuance on the long, smoothly tannic finish. Quite different in style from the 2005 (and the 2003, for that matter), this lacks some of the innate elegance of the Trinoro wines that contain a bit more of the two cabernets. But this is still superbly made wine. (T. Edward Wines, New York, NY)
